Ben was a freshman at Lakeland College where he was on the wrestling squad when he tragically died as a result of an automobile accident.

His life exemplified devotion and unequalled dedication to personal and spiritual development. Ben had a tremendous drive to be the best at everything he did and also had a strong conviction to his spiritual beliefs.

### **SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES**

A scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the following criteria:

- A graduating senior from Oakfield High School with plans to pursue post-secondary education
- Must have participated in a high school sport as well as other school activities
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 as demonstrated by high school transcript
- Written statement (400 words or less) describing:
  - a) Give an example of how your own personal drive has helped you to succeed;
  - b) How your involvement in high school activities have contributed to the person you are today;
  - c) How your belief system will help you and others in the future
  - d) What do you do in your life that goes above and beyond what’s expected relative to such things as: reaching your goals, your family, your work, and your spiritual beliefs?
