Bristol Morgan Bank Scholarship
(Formerly Bank of Oakfield Scholarship)

The Bristol Morgan Bank has introduced the “Five Cents for the Future” campaign which is designed to give back to the youth of the surrounding communities. Every time a client swipes a Bristol Morgan Bank debit or credit card, the Bank will donate five cents to the Bristol Morgan Bank Scholarship Fund. The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships that may be renewed for a total of four years of post secondary education to high school graduates living in Fond du Lac or Dodge County. **Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to two new graduating seniors every year and will be renewable to the student for up to four years.**

Locally owned and operated, Bristol Morgan Bank has been doing business in Fond du Lac County for over 110 years. As a community bank, they provide local service for individuals, businesses and agricultural professionals across the community.

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

\$1,000 renewable scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the following criteria:

- A graduating senior of a Fond du Lac or Dodge County High School and/or a legal resident of Fond du Lac or Dodge County.
- Student must be a ***Bristol Morgan Bank*** customer or child/grandchild of a customer. *Employees, children or grandchildren of Bristol Morgan employees are not eligible to apply.*
- Scholarship may be renewed for a total of up to four years including initial year of award
- Student must be pursuing a technical college degree or baccalaureate degree
- Recipient should be recognized as a full time student
- Scholarship awarded to technical college graduate may apply additional eligibility to baccalaureate degree if applicant goes directly from technical college to pursue baccalaureate degree
- Minimum GPA of 2.5
- Personal Statement, School Activities, Community Service & Involvement, and Job/Work History

APPLICANT MUST:

1. Submit a most recent **CERTIFIED** high school transcript. Applications without this requirement **WILL NOT** be considered.
2. Applications must be received or postmarked by **March 31**, and mailed to:
