During her time at Lawrence, Kayla was responsible for the successful project management of a multifaceted annual giving program; strengthened leadership giving through development and implementation of a comprehensive marketing and fundraising plan; oversaw direct mail programs and digital campaigns; set consecutive annual fund fundraising records with over \$3.9 million from over 9,500 donors; and boasted an 80% donor retention rate.

The Fond du Lac Area Foundation was established with one fund from a contribution of \$53,000 from the disbanded Fond du Lac Children's Home in 1975. As of 2020, the Foundation has more than 375 funds and over \$48,000,000 in assets. Each of those funds represent a unique charitable interest, including support for scholarships, churches, youth activities, the arts, the needy, the environment, and more. Those endowment funds are now generating more than \$1,400,000 each year that is being returned to the community in the form of charitable grants and scholarships. The Foundation has one regional affiliate, the Beaver Dam Area Community Foundation.
