Jolayne Ingebritson Memorial Scholarship Established to Empower Future Female Engineers

Fond du Lac, Wis. (July 29, 2021): Created through the Fond du Lac Area Foundation, the Jolayne Ingebritson Memorial Scholarship honors the lifework of Jolayne (Jo) Karren Ingebritson (1962-2021) who died unexpectedly on March 16, 2021 at her home in the Dominican Republic.

Jo's husband, Denis Entringer, along with many families, co-workers, and friends, are honoring her dedication to empowering the next generation of female engineers through a scholarship.

The Jolayne Ingebritson Memorial Scholarship will afford female graduating high school students in Dodge and Fond du Lac Counties the opportunity to learn critical skillsets to propel them toward a fulfilling career, much like the one Jo built.

Born in Aberdeen, South Dakota, Jo was a well-respected and hardworking engineer, a steady and dedicated employee who earned numerous patents throughout her career, a hands-on mother to two sons, and a good-hearted friend and family member to many.

Jo always gave her best to her engineering career, having established Ingebritson Engineering, Inc. and being employed by major manufacturing companies Honeywell and, most recently, Mercury Marine.

During her years at Mercury Marine, Jo built friendships, teamwork, comradery, and a legacy of excellence both in the United States and throughout the various where countries she traveled to. She dedicated herself to learning difference languages and embracing each culture she experienced. Jo retired from Mercury Marine in the spring of 2020.

Each year, beginning in 2022, female graduating seniors throughout Dodge and Fond du Lac Counties who plan to earn a degree in engineering may apply for the Jolayne Ingebritson Memorial Scholarship.

As of 2021, the Foundation has over \$65 million in assets and more than 425 funds.
