This is the Foundation's third move since its establishment in 1975. Beginning at the home of founder Carl, their location shifted once in 1989 and again in 2002 to the current address of 384 N. Main Street.

The move takes the Foundation from North Main Street to South Main Street; specifically, to the address of 1020 S. Main Street (formerly the Wisconsin Title building).

The new location holds five business suites on two levels, and the Foundation will be situated in the lower level in Suite E.

Donors, community partners, and guests will be welcomed into the business suite with warm colors, individual staff offices, a private meeting room, a large board room, and updated technology. The new building offers an accessible layout with stairs, an elevator, and increased parking, and it is surrounded by a thriving business park.

The Fond du Lac Area Foundation was established with one fund from a contribution of \$53,000 from the disbanded Fond du Lac Children's Home in 1975. As of 2020, the Foundation has more than 425 funds and over \$55,000,000 in assets. Each of those funds represent a unique charitable interest, including support for scholarships, churches, youth activities, the arts, the needy, the environment, and more. Those endowment funds are now generating more than \$1,400,000 each year that is being returned to the community in the form of charitable grants and scholarships.
