SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:

Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the following student criteria:

1. Graduating senior of Fond du Lac High School or Oakfield High School
2. Plans to pursue a degree at a college, university, trade school, or technical school
3. Financial need
4. Passing grades (eligible for admission to school/college of application)
4. Written statement (see application for details)
5. Upon verification and receipt of scholarship application, winner will be selected by a committee. Decision of committee is final. Scholarship check will be issued jointly to recipient and college upon proof of enrollment.
