



Fondy 100 Gives brings together 100 passionate individuals to fund projects that provide an immediate, positive impact in our community.

Grant Requirements:

- *Project must provide **immediate positive impact to the Fond du Lac area**. Application and presentation must clearly articulate how it will positively impact the community.*
- *Application must clearly identify a project or program with an approximate budget of \$7,500. Fondy 100 Gives grants are not intended for large projects where we are one of many funders.*
- *Must be a qualified 501(c)3 non-profit organization with a Fond du Lac County address and serving the Fond du Lac County community. Schools and municipalities are also qualified 501©3 organizations for the purpose of this grant.*

Timeline

Applications due approximately three weeks prior to the next Fondy 100 Gives event. Check website for grant deadline and to download a copy of the application:

All qualified applications (see below) will be entered into a Facebook Live drawing that will be held approximately 2 weeks prior to each Fondy 100 Gives Meeting. Three non-profit applications will be drawn randomly. Those drawn will provide a 5-minute presentation and 5-minute question and answer session to Fondy 100 Gives Members. Time limitations are strictly enforced. The membership will then vote for the organization that they feel should receive \$7,500 in funding. Only one organization is funded at each meeting, as determined by the greatest number of votes.

Organizations that have received funding from Fondy 100 Gives in the 3 years preceding the application deadline are not eligible to apply.

Organizations that are chosen to present but not selected for funding are not eligible to apply for one year after their presentation.

Organizations may only have one application submitted for each drawing (may withdraw prior applications to submit new applications).

Applications will be eligible for one year after submission, unless otherwise withdrawn by the non-profit.
