

## Basic Needs 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Grant

## **Grant Description**

The Basic Needs Grant, a special **one-time initiative** of the Fond du Lac Area Foundation in honor of its 50th Anniversary, is an impact grant designed to support nonprofit organizations that provide essential services to children and families facing hardship within the Fond du Lac area.

## One \$50,000 grant will be awarded.

Applications must be submitted by 11:30 p.m. on July 31, 2025.

This **\$50,000 grant** prioritizes projects that directly address basic needs, including but not limited to:

- Food Security: Programs providing meals, food boxes, or nutritional support.
- Housing Stability: Initiatives offering emergency shelter, rental assistance, or support to prevent homelessness.
- Clothing and Hygiene: Projects supplying clothing, personal hygiene items, or laundry services.
- Essential Household Items: Programs providing furniture, bedding, or other necessary household goods.
- **Transportation Assistance:** Initiatives supporting access to transportation for essential appointments or services.
- **Emergency Assistance:** Programs providing immediate financial aid for critical needs.

The Fond du Lac Area Foundation, celebrating 50 years of service to the community, seeks to support organizations demonstrating a commitment to serving vulnerable populations, a track record of effective service delivery, and a clear understanding of the needs within the Fond du Lac community. This special anniversary grant reflects the Foundation's enduring commitment to strengthening families and building a brighter future for Fond du Lac.
