



Beaver Dam Area Giving 100 Grant Application

Grant Overview

Beaver Dam Area Giving 100 awards a **\$7,500 grant** to one eligible nonprofit organization at each meeting. Grants are intended to support a **specific project or program** that provides an **immediate and positive impact** to the Dodge County community.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, applicants must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- Be a qualified **501(c)(3) nonprofit organization**, school, church or municipality
- Have a **physical address located in Dodge County**
- Serve the **Dodge County community**
- Request funding for a **clearly defined project or program** with an approximate budget of **\$7,500**
- Project must not be part of a large initiative with multiple funders
- Organization **must not have received funding from Beaver Dam Area Giving 100 within the past three (3) years**

Additional eligibility notes:

- Organizations selected to present but not funded are **not eligible to apply again for one year** following their presentation
- Only **one application per organization** may be submitted per drawing
- Applications remain eligible for **one year after submission**, unless withdrawn by the organization

Application Timeline & Process

- Applications are due **approximately two weeks prior** to each Beaver Dam Area Giving 100 event
- All qualified applications are entered into a **Facebook Live random drawing** held approximately **two weeks prior** to the meeting. Drawing one day after deadline.
- **Three organizations** are randomly selected to present
- Selected organizations will provide:
 - **5-minute presentation**
 - **5-minute Q&A session** (strictly enforced)
- Beaver Dam Area Giving 100 members vote by ballot
- The organization receiving the **most votes** is awarded the \$7,500 grant

- Vote counts are **not shared**
